The Royal Treatment (a.k.a. Fun, Feast n' Flagon)

Fool around at **The MEDIEVAL MANOR**, where a bawdy but light hearted romp through the dark ages has been on the menu since 1973. Join in the interactive **Fun** of His Majesty, Minstrel, Jester, Oaf and Wenches entertaining you with slapstick and song. As Canterbury beckons, laughter and camaraderie will soon reveal why so many return so often for such foolishness. **Whatever the celebration, bring it to the King!**

Most everyone adds to their fun by adding our six course **Feast** eaten without fork, knife or spoon. It begins with warm loaves of bread, pepper cheese trenchers and faux Dragon soup. Mussels, beef rib and salad precede the final course, roasted herbed chicken with steamed vegetables. Vegetarian substitutes, cakes (some customers bring cupcakes) and side orders of ribs are available with 24 hours notice.

While feasting, refill your glass from a full pitcher of dark or light beer, a carafe of Chablis or non alcoholic mock mead (or a diet root beer) by redeeming a **Flagon** token, one token per person. Mixed drinks and bottled beer, soda or wine can also be purchased from the cash bar. Souvenir glasses are also available. Bringing one from a previous visit can save you up to \$25. Call for details.

Not all that hungry or thirsty? When you call **(617) 423-4900** to book your reservation, if you tell us, the feast and flagon won't come.

Medieval Manners (Chivalry is not dead)

- Management notes it's obligation to limit or withhold the service of alcoholic beverages (or even deny admittance to intoxicated patrons). A noninvasive breath test device may be used to help evaluate blood alcohol levels. No refunds.
- The continued availability of cash bar beverages during intermissions is at the discretion of the manager.
- All guests must be at least 21 years old, be with their parent(s) or have our manager's approval prior to booking.
- Sorry, no video cameras or audible cell phones.
- Clothes are required but there is no need to dress up. Shorts are totally acceptable in months without an "r".
- As at any theatrical event, conversing with others as well as leaving or returning to your seat during the performance is unfair to everyone.

Accommodations

(July 2010)

We are 99.9% wheelchair accessible. Tables seat from five to twenty five. Whenever possible, parties of two, three or four are grouped to fill larger tables. We ask that parties not exceed 50. Private shows for 75 or more can be booked on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday after 6:30 or on Sunday before 1:00 or after 8:30. Private Thursday shows require 100 admissions, Fridays or Sundays 125 and Saturdays 150. We are a 21+ venue. **All shows have the same adult content** (self rated at **PG-15^{1/2}**) suitable for most families with older children, but everyone must be at least 18 years old Saturdays at 8:30.

All exceptions require managerial approval.

Birthday? Bringing the kids on a Sunday? Large group, Red Hatter or senior? In college? Military? Ask about **Royal Treatment** discounts.

Location, Location, Location (call for updates)

In 1982, after 10 years in the basement of the Back Bay's Eliot Hotel, **we relocated to 246 East Berkeley Street**, between Albany and Harrison, in Boston's **South End**. We are in the first building on the right, across from a Mobil station.

Limited parking is available in our lot at \$10 per car

- **I-93 North to Exit 20** (South Station/I-90 East-West) Follow signs for South Station (avoiding Mass Pike). Turn left at the first light. Turn left at the next light onto **Albany Street**. At the third light turn right.
- **I-93 South to Exit 20-B** (Albany St/I-90 West) While in the tunnel, where **Exit 20-B's** one lane becomes two, stay right to avoid rejoining I-93. Once above ground, exit left onto **Albany Street**, just before the Mass Pike entrance. Turn right at the third light.
- **I-90 East to Exit 24-A** (South Station) At the first light turn left onto **Kneeland Street**. At **Surface Road** (the second light) turn left onto **Albany Street**. At the fourth light turn right.
- **Storrow Drive** Gain access to **Arlington Street** (no exit by that name). At Tremont, it veers to the left and becomes **Herald Street**. Just past the Boston Herald, turn right at the light onto **Albany Street**. At the second light turn right.
- **MBTA** On the **Red Line**, get off at **Broadway** and walk across the **Broadway Bridge**, under I-93, turning left at **Albany** and right at **East Berkeley**, an 8-10 minute walk.

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Times and Tariffs

(July 2010)

On Saturday, our general admission shows are at 4:30 and 8:30. There is one such show on Sunday at 4:30. On Thursday or Friday they are at 7:45. Doors to the cocktail lounge open about 30 minutes before the show. Parking lot opens about 15 minutes before doors. We begin seating almost immediately and ask that you arrive at least 15 minutes before the show. Show ends about 3 hours after doors open.

Just want the **Fun**? As low as **\$19!** Most everyone adds the **Feast** for **\$7** (\$6.56 plus 6.25% MA meals tax) **n' Flagon** (redeemable beer, wine, mock mead or diet root beer token) for **\$4** (meals tax included). On Sunday and Thursday, tickets for this **Royal Treatment** are **\$30**. Tip, parking lot and any gift shop or cash bar purchases are not included. Tickets are **\$40** on Fridays and at Saturday 4:30 shows. Saturday tickets at 8:30 are **\$50**. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Sunday private-show-for-75-or-more **Royal Treatment** tickets (with full tip and parking) are **\$33.50** (add **\$75** for bar service). **Not so Fun?** Meal with token for two or more at the bar, \$10.35 each plus 6.25% MA meals tax prepaid 24 hours in advance.

Reservations are required and are frequently available on the day of the performance. Tickets go on sale 90 days in advance. Box office opens by noon Tuesday through Friday, by 2:00 on Saturday and most Sundays and Mondays. **Call (617) 423-4900.**

Advance payment by Visa/MC/Discover, cash, check, money order or gift certificate is due within 10 days after reserving. When time allows payment by mail (no multiple or second party checks), please indicate the show date and time, with the name and size of your party and send to **246 East Berkeley Street, Boston MA 02118**. Parties of 16 or more pay in full; all others deposit \$10 per person and pay the balance with cash or credit card the night of the show. To facilitate seating, we ask that just one person perform these tasks.

All payments are nonrefundable (or transferable to another show) unless we can resell your seats.

Only parties with \$10 per person deposits giving at least 24 hours notice may reduce without penalty (i.e. the full deposit will be applied against the balance. Unless mentioned at booking, all tickets by default are **Royal Treatment** (a.k.a. Fun, Feast n' Flagon) tickets. Changing the type of ticket requires at least 24 hours notice.
